No quantities of the substances listed explicitly in the above Directives, i.e. cadmium, lead, mercury and chromium VI, requiring declaration in accordance with VDA 232–101 / GADSL, are present in Saxonia-Franke AG raw material or any of its processes.

Products from Saxonia-Franke AG are manufactured from defined steel quality (standards). They are free from hazardous substances, conflict minerals and radioactivity, as well as ionising radiation in excess of natural radiation. Likewise, the thin corrosion-protection film applied to some tube surfaces does not contain any hazardous substances requiring declaration in accordance with the Hazardous Substances Ordinance, nor any other substances requiring declaration.
